- Completed or working toward a college degree in a related field (i.e. psychology, nonprofit management, social work, ministry leadership, etc.).
- An effective communicator in written and oral form
- Strong desire to provide God's healing to those affected by abuse and trauma
- Well organized, self-motivated, flexible and dedicated to helping in a support role
- Computer skills, especially in Microsoft Word, Excel and Publisher
- Comfortable working alone on assignments and in collaboration with others
- Previous project management a plus
- Previous internship or related experience a plus
- Videography skills a plus
- Candidate will need to pass a criminal background check
